INFORMATION SHEET

In addition to the requirements set out in the application form for the volunteer position of Auxiliary Police Constable with the Sault Ste. Marie Police Service all successful applicants must:

- be prepared to participate in and successfully complete an extensive period of training here at the Sault Ste. Marie Police Services Building. A flexible training schedule will be developed that best accommodates the Service and any commitment that an applicant might have outside of his or her commitment to the Auxiliary Policing Unit
- after having successfully completed the period of training be prepared to serve a minimum of 12 hours per month once sworn as an Auxiliary Police Constable with the Sault Ste. Marie Police Service

Applications will not be accepted from

- persons licenced as a private investigator or security guard

The Police Service will

- assume all costs associated with the training and equipment requirements of a member of the Auxiliary Policing Unit

Selection

In determining successful candidates for the position of Auxiliary Police Constable consideration will be given to the needs of the organization and as such the most qualified candidate may not always be the individual selected for the position.
